Main Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Prepare, monitor and review Local Development Documents for Peterborough to a standard, speed and quality that are recognised for their excellence. This may include minerals and waste policy work jointly with Cambridgeshire County Council where necessary.
2. Work on other strategic planning projects and monitoring tasks as required, such as the preparation of Supplementary Planning Documents and the Statement of Community Involvement, and assisting parish councils and neighbourhood forums in their preparation of neighbourhood plans

and/or orders.

3. Contribute to wider strategic housing and environmental policy and strategy formulation and corporate regeneration projects.
4. Contribute to corporate and inter-departmental projects
5. Assist the council in fulfilling any contract to provide a service to any other council, by undertaking duties and responsibilities appropriate to this post.
6. Adopt a problem-solving approach to ensure that tasks and projects consistently achieve their objectives.
7. Deputise for the Principal Strategic Planning Officers and the Housing and Strategic Planning Manager as required.
8. Prepare and present written and oral evidence as an expert witness on behalf of the Council at public examinations, hearings, committees and written appeals as required.
9. Provide guidance and advice to customers and elected members on planning policies and related research matters.
10. Work on other policy and research projects as required by line management.
11. Depending on demand within the department, potentially undertake work at a commensurate level within Development Management from time to time.
