Job Purpose:	The role involves preparing and cooking menu items, maintaining kitchen cleanliness and supporting colleagues in daily kitchen operations. To achieve a balanced, nutritious and attractively presented range of food stuffs and beverages for the Home.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

1. To assist and produce a range of food stuffs and beverages for the Home. To support the service in promoting the need for a nutritious and balanced diet. Maintain Health and Safety and food hygiene standards. Preparation of drinks trays as required for meetings and other events held at the Home.

- 2. Within a rota pattern work undertaken One third cook duties (minimum 1 cook day per week) and two thirds kitchen Team Member Duties.
- 3. To maintain an awareness of the specific needs of individuals e.g. food allergens, vegetarians, controlled diets and ethnic minority groups.
- 4. At the direction of the Head Cook to take responsibility for high standards of food hygiene including maintaining the cleanliness of all kitchen areas and food equipment. This will include keeping safe food records and the execution of cleaning schedules.
- 5. To operate all kitchen equipment safely and to maintain security of equipment including the counting of cutlery etc after each meal. Reporting any loss of cutlery, equipment or faults to the Head Cook. To ensure equipment is left clean when not in use. Waste management. To have general health and safety and fire prevention awareness, including procedures relating to the Home.
- 6. To work as a team member in a way which supports colleagues within the Children's Home having appropriate respect for race, culture and gender issues.
- 7. To keep abreast of relevant developments, maintaining an awareness of current instructions circulated electronically, by staff meetings, information bulletins, circular letters or by verbal or written information given by Senior Managers. Participating in supervision, training and monitoring procedures designed to evaluate the impact of own work and that of the Home.
- 8. To carry out all responsibilities with regard to the Council's Equalities Policy and Customer Care Policy.
